## *Marksmanship Training*

### Marksmanship Practices (Naden Drill Shed)

Marksmanship Practices will be conducted on Sundays at the Naden Drill Shed (see map attached).

The goals of Recreational Marksmanship training is to:

1. Promote safe firearms handling.
2. Provide a fun and challenging experience.
3. Provide cadets with the opportunity to qualify for a marksmanship skill level badge by the end of the training year.
4. Identify and develop cadets for the corps marksmanship team.

### Date & Time

Dates will be printed on the monthly calendar and can be found on the corps web site. Practices will always be confirmed on the Tuesday prior to each practice. Initially practices will be conducted as follows:

**Green and Red star cadets: 1:00pm to 4:00pm.** (Those cadets from last year who were using a Jacket and sling may show up at 10:00am)

**Silver, Gold and Master cadet: 10:00am to 4:00pm.** (Those who stay past 1:00pm will assist with green and red stars.) Drill shed will be open by 9:45 am.

### **Things you should know:**

- Lunch is not provided. Please bring a snack and drink if you think you will be hungry.
- Only enrolled cadets are allowed to attend the marksmanship training. (Sorry, no non-cadet friends, or family)
- New cadets will receive introductory training during this practice to allow them to safely fire the air rifle the Daisy 853C air rifle.
- Dress is appropriate civilian clothing for indoor training that you don't mind getting dirty.
- Cadets will be lying down on mats on a paved drill hall floor. Wear a long sleeved shirt, hoodie, or old sweater. Recommend wearing corps dry fit shirt and hoodie.
- The afternoon session will be dismissed promptly at 4pm.
- Always wash your hands after handling the lead pellets and before touching food.
