### **SITUATION**

1. In accordance with (IAW) references, the South Vancouver Island area is to provide Professional Development Workshops (hereafter referred to as workshops) for cadets enrolled in Phase 5, Master Cadet, or Proficiency Level 5. The South Vancouver Island area will host workshops for all three (3) elements 16-18 Nov 18 at Work Point Barrack, in Esquimalt BC. In addition to the workshops, a Cadet Correspondent Workshop will be delivered by Public Affairs to provided training to 15 South Vancouver Island area cadets.

### **MISSION**

2. Conduct the workshops IAW references in order to offer cadets the opportunity to complete the required four (4) workshop sessions for PO 513. The workshop will be conducted on the dates outlined in the Master Activity Calendar (16-18 Nov 2018). The Cadet Correspondent Workshop will run in conjunction with the overnight Year 5 workshops and will be a separate serial in Fortress.

### **EXECUTION**

- 3. <u>Location</u>. The workshops will be held at the Naval Officer Training Centre (Venture Building), 1094 Victoria View Road, Esquimalt BC.
- 4. Coordinating Instructions
  - a. <u>Dress.</u> C2 for Army / Air cadets and C3A for Sea cadets (parka may worn if desired).

- b. <u>Transportation</u>. Local Corps/Squadron COs shall ensure parents arrange travel for their cadets to the training location. Cadets to arrive at Work Point Barracks NLT 2030 hrs on Friday, 16 Nov 18. Cadets shall be picked up absolutely NLT 1330 hrs on 18 Nov 18. See Annex A for the pickup / drop-off location.
  - (1) cadets traveling from Parksville & Ladysmith will have DND transportation provided. Specific timings will be communicated to corps/sqn CO's NLT 14 Nov 18.

- (1) 0830-1140 hrs Fourth set of workshops delivered,
- (2) 1140-1200 hrs Feedback session,
- (3) 1200-1300 hrs Lunch,
- (4) 1300 hrs Cadets can depart, must be departed prior to 1330 hrs.
- d. Required Kit. All items of kit and personal belongings must be marked clearly with the cadet's name and cadet squadron number. Parents/guardians and cadets are reminded that all personal items are the responsibility of the owner. The followings items are required:

<u>Prohibited Items</u> . The following items are prohibited and shall not be brought under any circumstances:

- (5) combat clothing or equipment;
- (6) firearms/weapons (including toy replicas);
- (7) knives;
- (8) lighters or other fire starting items;
- (9) tobacco products;
- (10) straight blade razors; and
- (11) pornographic material.
- f. <u>Medical</u>. Corps/Squadron CO's are reminded to ensure all participating cadets have a valid medical entered in Fortress and that their cadet's participation limitations are within tolerance for this activity.

## SERVICE SUPPORT

- 5. <u>Meals</u>. RCSU (Pac) has arranged rations to be provided at the training location by CFB Esquimalt:
  - a. Corps/Squadron COs are reminded that as per the CF 1158, the Canadian Armed Forces does not have the mandate, are not equipped nor staffed to offer allergenfree foods or food preparation conditions; and
  - b. Corps/Squadron CO's are required to contact J5 Plans Officer (Regional Training) of any dietary concerns for their cadets NLT 0900 hrs Wednesday, 14 November 2018.
- 6. <u>Accommodations.</u> Cadets and staff quarters have been arranged at Work Point Barracks for the duration of the workshops.

- 8. <u>Discipline</u>. In order to maintain a safe and orderly environment, cadets are required to follow the rules set out for the Canadian Cadet Organization. In the interest of providing a healthy environment, a strict no smoking policy exists for all cadet activities. No cadet will be

permitted to smoke and/or use any tobacco products.

- 9. Cadets may bring a personal cell phone, however the RCSU (Pac) will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 10. In cases of emergency, parents/guardians are to be directed to contact RCSU (Pac) at 250-363-0900.
