

2483 PPCLI Mt Washington Ski / Snowboarding Trip

Sunday, 20 January 2019

Drop off: 0530 HRS / 5:30 AM at Nixon Building at Workpoint – bus leaves 0545 sharp

Pick up: 1800-1830 HRS / 6:00-6:30 PM approx. at Nixon Building at Workpoint

Cadets who have never skied or boarded before must take a morning lesson; cadets with limited ski/board experience may also partake in a lesson. Cadets requiring rentals will be provided with skis or board, helmet, goggles and a lift ticket paid for by the corps. Cadets may bring their own ski / board gear at their own risk.

Cadets must pack suitable winter clothing – ski jacket and pants, underclothing, toque, winter gloves, warm socks and change of clothes for the ride home. A watch or cell phone to tell the time is required – cadets need to be aware of the time so they can meet their end of the day bus timing. Cadets who are late for the end of the day bus time will not be permitted to attend any future ski trips.

Cadets may pack their own snacks and lunch or bring money to buy food at the cafeteria – the bus will also stop at a gas station for a rest break. Lockers at Mt Washington are \$1.00 for personal bags, etc.

Last year we had cadets “no show” for the trip after signing up and in some cases were registered for lessons – valid reasons for not showing up were not provided or communicated in advance. This is a very costly event and simply “no showing” is not acceptable.

Most cadets, who are available for the trip, have already signed up. Tuesday, January 8th at cadets will be the last opportunity to sign up – Captain Dahl will do a final call to sign up just before or following the dismissal parade.
